In order to maintain a permit requires the Village to submit a Notice of Intent (NOI) and an Annual Facility Inspection Report (AFIR) to the IEPA. Unlike the sewer system, which carries water from your indoor drains to wastewater treatment plants, the storm drain system releases untreated water into channels, streams and rivers.
